Schedule of Registration (Licence) Fees 01 April 2025 to 31 March 2026

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CONSERVANCY BASED VESSEL

Please visit our website for online applications: www.camconservancy.org/boat-registration

- 1. Complete and sign the **Application Form** on The Conservancy website. If you were registered with us in the previous registration year, please complete an online **Renewal Form**.
- 2. Provide a copy of a valid insurance certificate for the vessel.
- 3. Ensure that a valid Boat Safety Certificate is in place where necessary.
- 4. Pay the correct annual **Licence Fees** on or before 01 April 2025.
- 5. Ensure that the vessel is **clearly identified** with its unique registration number, clearly visible up to 15 metres from either side of the vessel. Photographic evidence may be required at the time of registration.
- 6. For vessels which become a Conservancy based vessel on or after the 1st of October during this registration year, having not been registered with the Conservancy in the previous registration year, a 50% discount may be applicable. The Anglian Pass covers visiting travel between 01 April 2025 to 31 March 2026, across both the Anglian, Environment Agency and Middle Level Commissioners waters for Powered Boaters visiting the Conservancy section of the River Cam. See www.visitanglianwaterways.org

VISITING VESSELS

Visitors Licences are not available from The Conservancy. However, for all vessels fully registered with our partners, the Middle Level Commissioners and the Environment Agency (Anglian waterways) or those who hold a Gold Licence, the Anglian Pass is available to purchase from the Environment Agency. The Anglian Pass is the only pass that allows visiting access to The Conservancy section of The River Cam. The other licences mentioned are simply prerequisites to obtaining The Anglian Pass 'AP'. The 'Anglian Pass' must be clearly displayed on the vessel. *Visit www.visitanglianwaterways.org.*

HOW TO PAY

Payment can be made either by bank transfer or by debit/credit card (via PayPal).

<u>INSTALMENTS</u>: Applications must be made to the CEO prior to 1st April 2025. If agreed, these must be paid via a standing order arrangement made by the applicant with their bank.

- For private vessels with an annual fee of £300 or more, the payment should be made in 10 equal payments monthly from April 2025 to end in January 2026. Payment reference for private vessels should be: Initial & Surname/Boat Name or Number
- For commercial vessels, 4 equal payments must be made via bank transfer on: 01 April 2025, 01 July 2025, 01 October 2025, and 01 January 2026. Payment reference should be "Organisation, Name, Vessel Registration".
